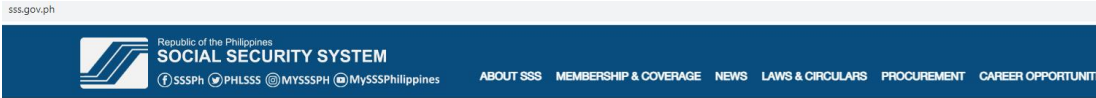

CSPP is the SSS' mechanism for partnership with government or non-government groups or individuals, that wish to fully subsidize the SSS contributions of self-employed (SE), land-based Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs), and voluntary members (VMs).

### DEFINITION OF TERMS


<b>Contribution Subsidy Provider (CSP)</b>	A private/government/group/individual that subsidizes the SSS contributions of identified SEs/Land-Based OFWs/VMs.
<b>Contribution Subsidy Recipient (CSR)</b>	A registered SE/Land-Based OFW/VM who shall enjoy the subsidy of their social security protection.
<b>Contribution Subsidy</b>	The total amount of SSS contributions to be shouldered by the CSP in favor of the CSR.
<b>Coverage &amp; Collection Partner (CCP)/ Contribution Subsidy Provider (CSP) Portal</b>	The designated portal in the SSS website ( <a href="http://www.sss.gov.ph">www.sss.gov.ph</a> ) where CSPs may register or log in.

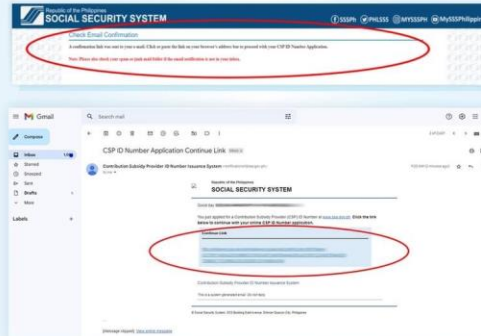

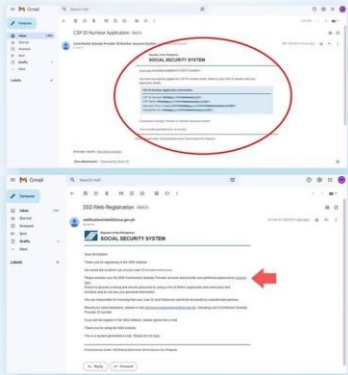

# SSS PROGRAMS FOR SELF-EMPLOYED

## Flexible Payment Schedule for Self-Employed in Informal Economy

- Oct 2022 implementation (SSS Circular No. 2022-028)
- Farmers: Four (4) or five (5) non-harvest months in a year
- Fishermen: Four (4) non-harvest months in a year (open seas)



# SSS PROGRAMS FOR SELF-EMPLOYED

## Flexible Payment Schedule for Self-Employed in Informal Economy

- Contributions for any of last twelve (12) months may be paid in current month
- To give farmers/fishermen all opportunities to pay social security contributions for all months in every year
- Expanded to other self-employed in informal economy

# SSS PROGRAMS FOR SELF-EMPLOYED

## Flexible Payment Schedule for Self-Employed in Informal Economy

- Self-employed in informal economy (initial determination)
  - Stall and market salespersons
  - Street food salespersons
  - Skilled agricultural, forestry, and fishery workers
  - Craft and related trades workers
  - Plant and machine operators and assemblers
  - Elementary occupations

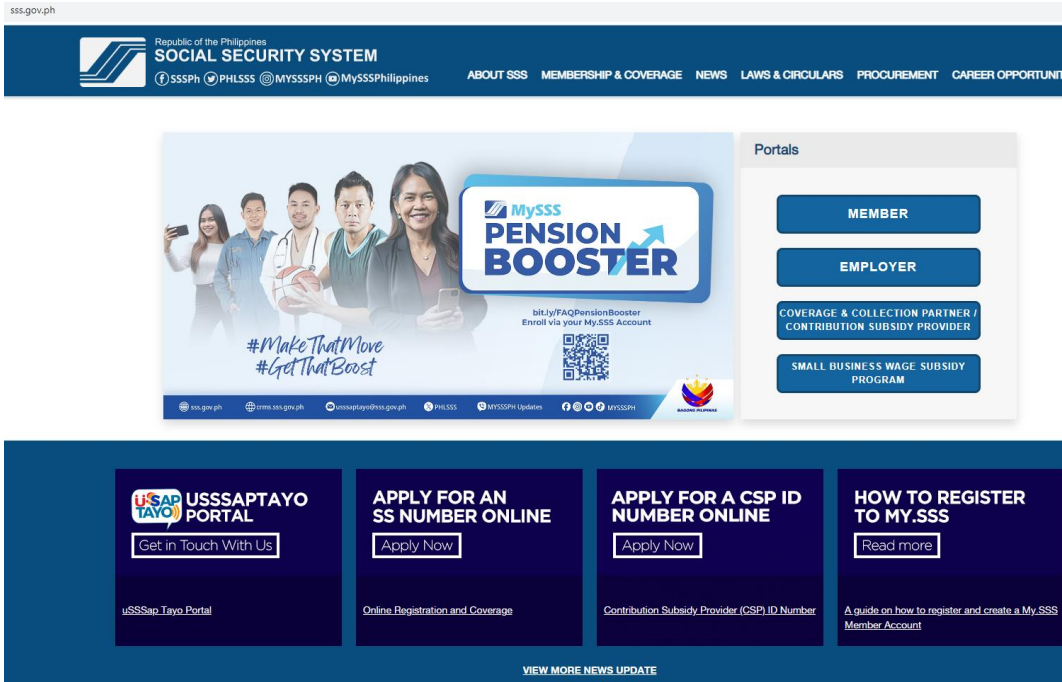

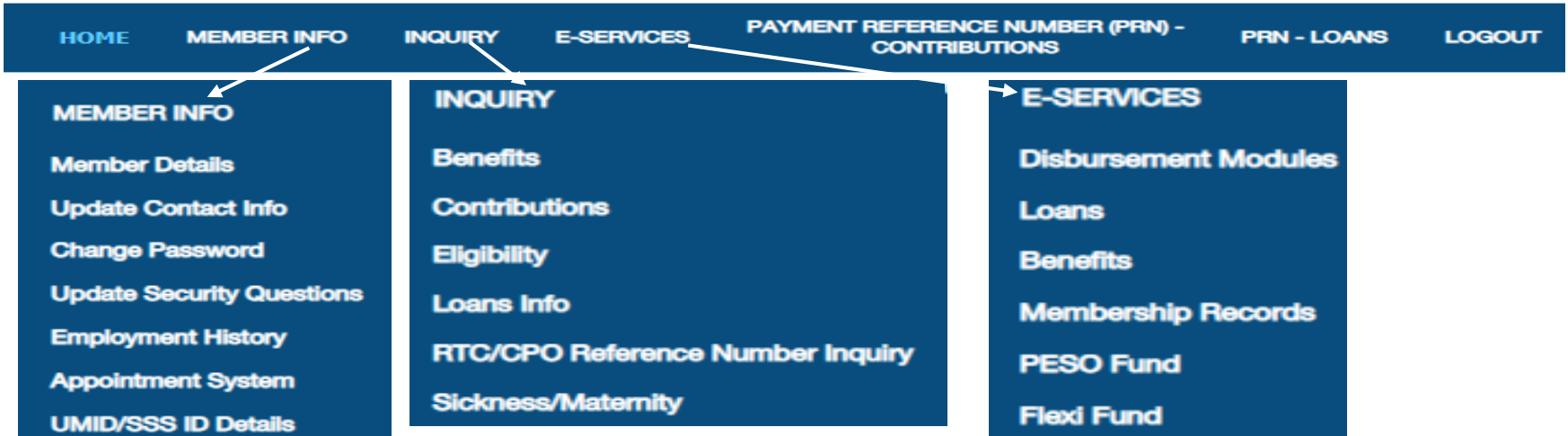

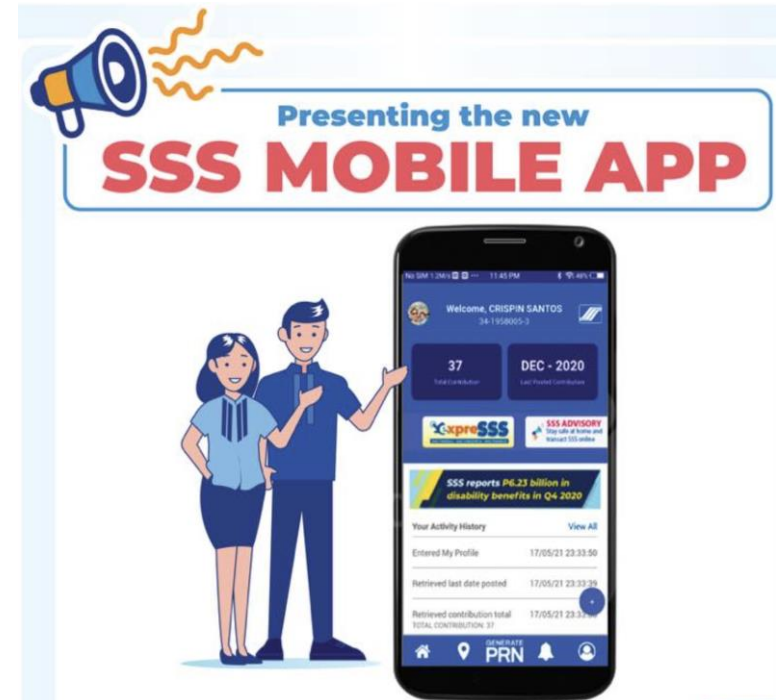
